ANDY BECK

is in demand as a guest conductor, choreographer, and clinician for music educators throughout the Country... a successful composer and arranger of top-selling chorals, musicals, and co-author of a highly regarded method book, "Sing at First Sight – Foundations in Choral Sight-singing"... following his nine year appointment as high school choral director in New York State, Mr. Beck joined the editorial team at Alfred Music where he currently serves as Director of School Choral, Classroom, and Vocal Publications.



TOM SHELTON

has conducted festivals and honor choirs for middle school and high school students in 17 states and abroad, including ACDA divisional and all-state honor choirs in 11 states... his compositions have been published by 7 different publishers including Heritage, Hinshaw, Santa Barbara, Walton, etc. ...Mr. Shelton is assistant Professor of Music at Westminster Choir College focusing on teaching classes in conducting and music education; as well as Conductor of the Princeton Girl Choir's Cantores (high school) ensemble... currently he is also serving as National President-Elect of ACDA.



DAVID BRUNNER

is an imaginative composer who has received yearly ASCAP awards since 1997 and in 2000 joined a prestigious group of American composers when he was named Raymond W. Brock Commissioned Composer by the American Choral Directors Association...Dr. Brunner is Professor of Music and Director of Choral Activities at the University of Central Florida and well-known for his work with singers of all ages, appearing as a popular honor choir director, clinician and composer in 34 states and around the world...New York Times has noted him as a "prolific choral writer whose name figures prominently on national repertory lists".



ROGER EMERSON

has over 500 choral titles in print and 15 million copies in circulation... he is one of the most widely performed choral composers in America today... he served as music specialist for 12 years in the Mt. Shasta Public School System, taught at the college level in Northern California, and now devotes fulltime to composing, arranging and consulting... for 12 years running, Mr. Emerson has been awarded ASCAP's Standard Award; as well as performances of his work at The Kennedy Center, The White House and Carnegie Hall.

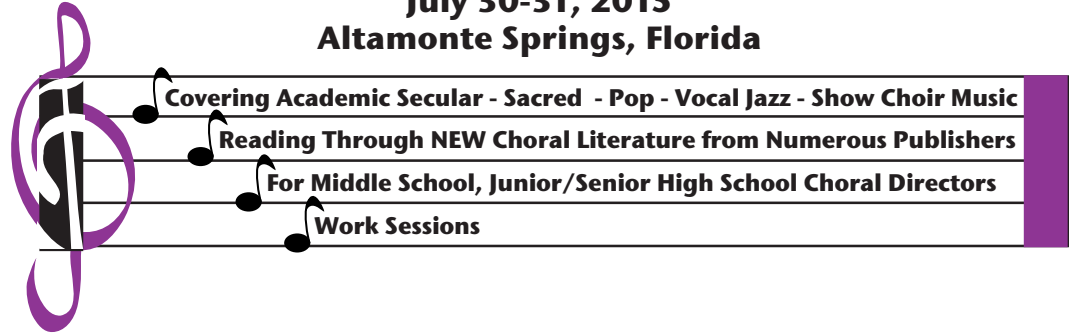
